- ▶ The International Observatory on Participatory Democracy (IOPD) is a space open to all cities in the world, associations, organizations and research centers interested in learning about, exchanging impressions and applying experiences of participatory democracy on a local scale with the aim of deepening the roots of democracy in municipal government.
- ▶ The **International Observatory on Participatory Democracy (IOPD)** has two kind of members:
  - ▶ - **Associate member:** local and regional governments, and other levels of governments.
  - ▶ - **Collaborating member:** civil society organizations and research centers that works around participatory democracy.

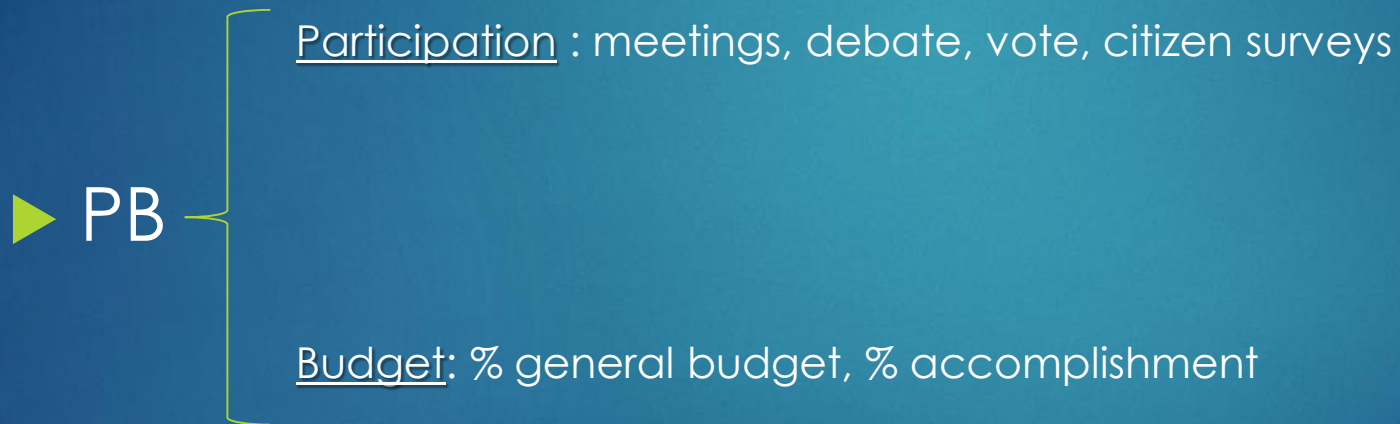
